4 butterfly cakes (lemon flavour)

Set recipe - Empire biscuits

Ingredients

For the biscuits, makes 4 sandwich biscuits - 8oz plain flour, 4oz caster sugar, 4oz butter/margarine, 1 egg

To decorate - jam, water icing & glacé cherries

Method

1. Mix together the flour and sugar. Rub in butter/margarine with fingertips.
2. Add enough egg to make stiff dough.
3. Roll out on a floured board thinly and cut into 8 rounds.
4. Place on a greased tray and bake in moderate oven until golden.
5. When cool, sandwich 2 biscuits together with jam in the middle. Top each sandwich with water icing and half a glacé cherry.
