3 pea pods	Any misshapen vegetable
3 potatoes	Tray of mixed vegetables, judged on variety and quality
3 tomatoes, with stalks	

### *FLORAL ARRANGEMENTS*

- 3 dahlia
- 3 chrysanthemum
- 3 gladioli
- A mixed arrangement of dahlia, chrysanthemum and gladioli
- 3 best sweet peas in a jam jar
