## Beamish Annual Pass – Conditions of Use

1. The Annual Pass card must be produced on entry. If you do not have your Pass, you will be asked to pay non-refundable admission charges.
  2. The Annual Pass is not transferable. Only those named on the Pass will be admitted free of charge and you may be asked for proof of identity.
  3. Use of the Pass by anyone other than the named member will result in cancellation of the Pass with no refund.
  4. Children aged less than 17 years must be accompanied by an adult.
  5. Children aged less than 17 years holding an Annual Pass as part of a the Family Pass scheme will not be admitted unless accompanied by at least one named adult on the Family Pass.
  6. If your Pass has been lost or stolen you should telephone the Beamish Museum Annual Pass office, 0191 370 2533 to report it immediately. We are unable to issue a replacement Pass without prior notice. Please allow 5 working days for a replacement Pass to be issued. (Proof of identity will be required on issue of a replacement Pass and any previous Pass held will be cancelled on issue of a replacement Pass). An administration fee of £5 is payable.
  7. The benefits of the Annual Pass may not be used in conjunction with any other concessions, discounts, group visit or for commercial/business use.
  8. A paid-up Annual Pass entitles each member to unlimited free visits for twelve months from the date of issue, subject to the conditions above.
  9. The Annual Pass fee quoted applies from 14<sup>th</sup> March 2008 to 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2009 inclusive.
  10. The Annual Pass cannot be used for Special Events outside regular opening times.

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The Direct Debit Guarantee – Please keep this for your information
